Approach Guidance:

Faith Settings:

- This can be done in conjunction with Toolkit Item "Engaging faith leaders"
- 2. Reach out to local faith leaders to let them know about POST program
- 3. Offer to work with families or survivors who may need additional support
- Offer to give naloxone to be kept on hand at the church or given out to families that request it
- Ask faith leaders if they would be interested in accompanying you on outreach in specific situations where they may be helpful or needed

Restaurants:

- Contact local restaurant owners to tell them about POST program
- 2. Offer naloxone and training for staff
- 3. Sharps container installation

Bars / Clubs

- Contact bar/club owners to tell them about POST program
- 2. Offer fentanyl test strips to be kept on hand, naloxone and training as needed
- 3. Discuss siting of a NaloxBox and sharps container

Schools:

- 1. Contact school nurses, social workers or guidance counselors
- 2. Discuss current drug supply challenges, fentanyl in pills/powder cocaine
- 3. Offer to stock the school with naloxone, to deliver trainings to students and staff

Parks

- At parks where overdoses have occurred, contact Parks Department to discuss the siting of a NaloxBox in the park
- Explain needle pick-up policy and offer for a sharps container to be installed
- 3. Give phone number for pick-ups

Publicly Accessible Restrooms

- At public restrooms where overdoses have occurred, contact facility owner to discuss the siting of a NaloxBox in the area
- 2. Offer to install Sharps Container
- 3. Give phone number for pick-ups

Allied Healthcare Facilities

- Hospitals, outpatient clinics, primary care offices, specialist offices, surgical centers, dental care providers, behavioral health care offices are all places where overdoses can occur.
- 2. Offer to install a NaloxBox and sharp container in lobbies or restrooms

Construction Sites

 Construction sites are known hotspots for stimulant use. Talk to management or site foreman about having Naloxone on hand in case of accidental overdose
