

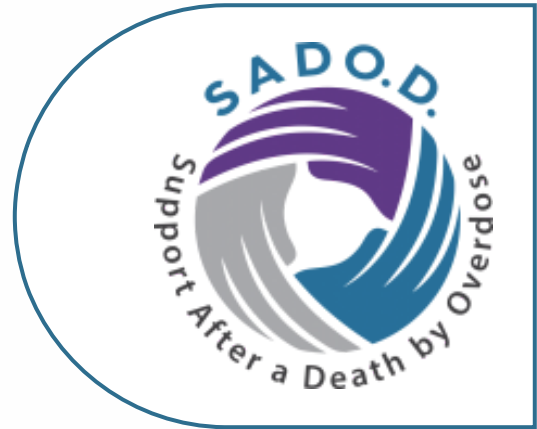
GRIEF SUPPORT RESOURCES

SUPPORT AFTER A DEATH BY OVERDOSE (SADOD)

- Best for: Bereaved people, frontline care providers, and people in recovery or struggling with substance use
